



While I am away I thought for my article space I would update you on the what is going on with the proposed bike lane on D Street. Here I share an email I received from Jill Alofs dated, April 18:

I reached out to the DSLC - a disability legal nonprofit group for Sonoma and they will be writing a letter to the city attorney. I am in contact with two other groups as well. I'm also putting colored Easter egg flyers (my children are helping me) on all Butter & Egg parade people who park on D St. I want them to know what city council wants to do and ask them to write their city council.

The final vote on this will not be till 2026 so our focus is now on elections. November will be elections for the 4th, 5th & 6th districts and then the mayor. If we can get three balanced people elected out of those 4 seats then in 2026 the D St proposal for bike lanes would not be voted in as a permanent road change and everything would return to how it is now. We have options.

I'll keep you posted.






