Pastor's Message

FEBRUARY: A TIME OF PURIFICATION, REBIRTH AND HOPE

As year 2025 is still in its prime stage of inchoation, now reaching the second month that is so much infused with symbolic meanings, makes us see our spiritual journey as members of the Petaluma United Methodist Church full of optimism and ebullience. February is associated with purification, rebirth and hope. The month's name comes from the Latin word februum, which means purification. The iris flower, a February birth flower, symbolizes connection, communication and spirituality. Having this idea of connection in mind, we see the United Methodist Church observes every year the history of the month that recognized and appreciate the way women and people of general different races and culture have contributed to the richness of its common life. Adorning a versatile character, members of the PUMC had demonstrated strength in their interracial relation and savors their communal gatherings and social interaction with love, honor and respect. When life is well purified in the church we will hear more mellifluous music reverberating in our ears, echoing hope of unity and mutual connection of members. We will be closely knitted together as one people. We will be able to stand together all the time and shoulder the workloads in the church, whether it is financial, maintenance of property, witnessing, serving others and many more. Moreover, the ministering tasks of the Word of God is an indispensable task for all members. We all enjoy the opportunities granted to us by God to share the Holy Word in our time of worship. Alongside, we also share the same sentiment of building the PUMC to grow strong and survive the tests of time. Financial growth in the church can happen if we reflect and delve deeply into the ministry of stewardship in months ahead. Only then, we will see our church not only growing in all aspects, but also as more of a

family than an organization, where everyone can have a sense of belonging and see in every task a notion of responsibility incumbent upon all of us to account for. 


